Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.5 dated 2.1.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 336, 341, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and under Sections 25, 27 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Counsel for the petitioner has stated that this FIR is a counter blast. In fact the complainant side had come to the house of the sister-in-law of the petitioner and had caused injuries to three female members of the family and as a consequence of which one DDR was lodged but they got the present FIR registered. Counsel for the petitioner has further stated that all the Sections areailable but the only allegation which have made the

On instructions from ASI Surjeet Singh, learned DAG has accepted these factual assertions.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer on 25.2.2019 and on any other date as and when his presence is required. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail by the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. In case the petitioner do not appear before the investigating officer in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
