Present petition has been filed for seeking bail pending trial in FIR No.127, dated 25.06.2018 for the offences punishable under Sections 379-B(2), 411 IPC registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that case against the petitioner is concocted. Otherwise, no recovery is actually effected from the petitioner. The alleged recovery of mobile phones have been thrust upon the petitioner because one day before that; some mobile phones were recovered by the same police station from some cricket bookies, as was reported in the press also. The petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2018. The challan has already been filed in the case. The petitioner is not required for any further investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State counsel being instructed by ASI Charanjeet submits that the petitioner is involved in serious offence of snatching. Therefore, he does not deserve to be released on bail. However, it is not disputed that the challan in the case has already been filed.

In view of the above, but without commenting any further on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is granted the concession of bail pending trial. He be released on bail pending trial subject to furnishing bail bonds/ surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
