AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Being aggrieved of order dated 02.01.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Gurugram allowing the application filed under Order VII Rule 11 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, the present Civil Revision Petition has been filed.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the effect that plaintiff be granted some reasonable time to affix the court fee.

For the view being taken, it is not deemed necessary at this stage to issue notice to the respondents.

The petitioner is granted six weeks' time to affix the court fee. If needful is done within said period, the Civil Court shall proceed in accordance with law.
