Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.92 dated 08.04.2017 under Sections 147, 149, 324, 436, 452, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mohindergarh.

Learned senior counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 16.01.2019 and, in fact, she has no role in the alleged occurrence. Similarly placed co-accused Gyani Devi was admitted to bail as per order dated 13.12.2018 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul and co-accused Rajender and Vijay Singh were ordered to be released on bail as per order of this Court dated 03.07.2017 and 20.09.2017 respectively. Trial of the case still to take some more time, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner

Taking all these facts into consideration, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, at this stage, which may not cause prejudice to any of the party and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 16.01.2019; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners behind the bar any more, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Saroj Devi is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on her furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
