This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.164 dated 21.09.2018 registered under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar.

The allegation against the petitioner was of recovery of 110 Rexogesic injections which had contained salt Buprenorphine Hydrochloride.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Prem Pal has stated that two official witnesses have been examined and the remaining official witnesses will be examined on or before 10.05.2019 and till such time bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view

directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 10.05.2019 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
