ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 297, dated 26.12.2017, under Section 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Panipat Sadar, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had snatched a mobile phone and ₹2,000/- from the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner is in custody since 27.05.2018. The petitioner is 20 years of age and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Mehar Singh states that although the investigation has been completed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 20 years old, he is in custody for over a year and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
