The petitioner avers that her husband is running a chemist's shop and the CIA Staff is demanding illegal gratification from him under the threat of false implication in a case under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. Although representations dated 18.7.2018 (Annexure P-1) and 22.7.2018 (Annexure P-2) have been submitted, yet the police has failed to take any action thereupon.
