Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.144 dated 15.03.2018, registered at Police Station Pehowa, District Kurukshetra, under Sections 342, 357, 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, ₹27 lakh was given to the present petitioner alongwith co-accused for sending son of complainant

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to Canada. However, neither son of complainant was sent to Canada nor money was returned to the complainant despite compromise.

The petitioner has been in custody since 12.04.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
