The present appeal has been filed against the judgment acquitting the respondents.

It is the case of the prosecution that Paramjit Singh committed suicide as there was harassment at the hands of respondents. The brother of the deceased Charanjit Singh-respondent No.1, his uncle Balwant Singh used to reside in a house as joint family. Charanjit Singh and his uncle-Balwant Singh used to take drinks in their house by bringing people from outside and also used to play music at high pitch to which deceased always opposed. On 04.05.2010, Ex. Sarpanch-Gurjit Singh also came to the house and put pressure and got the signatures of the deceased on blank papers. The deceased hence frustrated therefrom committed suicide.

Learned Court after examining the evidence has found that there is no abetment to commit suicide. Still further, the Court has found that a compromise had been arrived at between the parties and according to

which the dispute was resolved.

This Court has heard learned counsel for the appellant at length and with his able assistance gone through the judgments passed by the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the appellant although, made since attempt to persuade this Court to take a different view, however, could not point out any material irregularity or perversity in the judgment.

In view thereof, there is no ground to interfere.

Appeal is dismissed.
