Petitioner has filed this petition for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 for conducting fair and expeditious enquiry in FIR No.291 dated 03.11.2018 under Sections 307/325/323/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The FIR was registered on 03.11.2018, wherein the petitioner himself has retracted from his statement given to the police thereby exonerating 5 persons, who were initially mentioned as an accused. Besides, the representation dated 17.01.2019 carries an averment that no action is being taken in the FIR, though a period of over 6 months has already elapsed.

Considering the contents of the petition and the representation, no case is made out to invoke inherent power under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.
