ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.133 dated 19.04.2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 & 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, District Rewari, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially it was the complaint case and the petitioner had been released on interim bail by the order dated 02.06.2017 of this Court and thereafter it was made absolute on 8.8.2017. However, later on, the complaint was converted into State case and the petitioner was appearing before the trial Court regularly.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 07.02.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Avtar Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 07.02.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
