Pleadings on record would indicate that an order dated 16.08.2018 was passed by the District Registrar, Panipat, disapproving an amendment in the byelaws of Shree Gaushala Society (Registered) Panipat for want of requisite coram. The society having preferred an appeal under Section 79 of the Haryana Registration and Regulations of Societies Act, 2012, the State Registrar of Societies Haryana, passed an order dated 13.11.2018 setting aside the order dated 16.08.2018, passed by the District Registrar.

The present petitioner has then preferred an appeal before the Registrar General Firms and Societies against the order dated 13.11.2018 passed by the State Registrar of Societies.

The short prayer raised in the petition is that inspite of the appeal having been preferred on 09.01.2019, the same has not been listed for hearing till date.

Counsel for the petitioner would argue that the appeal was

accompanied with an application seeking certain interim directions and it would work to the serious prejudice of the petitioner who happens to be a member of the society, in case the appeal as also the application for interim directions is not listed and taken up for hearing, before the Registrar General, Firms and Societies, expeditiously.

In the pre lunch session a complete copy of the writ paper-book has been handed over to Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, to complete instructions.

The matter having been taken in the post lunch session, learned State counsel, has apprised the Court that the appeal preferred by the petitioner has been listed before the Registrar General, Firms and Societies on 08.03.2019. He however on instructions from Som Parkash, Joint Registrar of Societies, Haryana, makes a statement that keeping in view the urgency in the matter, the date in the appeal as also the accompanying application for interim directions would be preponed to 08.02.2019 for hearing. Statement of learned State counsel is accepted.

In the light of such statement made by learned State Counsel, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition.

Petition disposed of as infructuous.

It is further clarified that this Court has not examined the issue on merits.
