Vide this order, CRM-M-5417, 5156, 5160 and 3855 of 2019
for grant of regular bail of the petitioner, who is common in all these
petitions, shall stand disposed of.

Prayer in the petition(s) is to grant regular bail in FIR No.82, FIR No.83, FIR No.81 and FIR No.80 dated 26.08.2016 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B, 201 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 14.09.2018 and the investigations have been completed. He further submits that the case is triable by the Magistrate and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take time. He further submits that the petitioner is not the person who had borrowed the loan. He further relies upon the orders passed qua the petitioner in other cases of similar nature i.e. in CRM-M-24665 of 2019 dated 16.07.2019 and CRM-M-5103 of 2019 dated 30.05.2019.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from SI Bikramjit Singh, has submitted that the petitioner is accused in large number of cases.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail (in these 4 petitions) subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.

Accordingly, all the present petitions are allowed.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any in all these cases, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
