Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 28.11.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting her year of birth as 1996. They have also moved a representation

Amritsar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural), District Amritsar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
