On a question posed by this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is unable to contact the petitioner despite best efforts.

2. The present writ petition was admitted in the year 2000. Record of the case reflects that the petitioners joined the services sometime in the year 1980. By rough estimate, currently the age of the petitioners would be more than 73 years and by sheer efflux of time, the nature of relief sought by them, in the present petition, seems to have been rendered infructuous.

3. Accordingly, writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However liberty is granted to the petitioners to file an appropriate application, if any cause of action still survives.
