Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.204 dated 31.12.2018, registered under Sections 354, 323, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

A quarrel ensued with regard to panchayat elections.

Learned State counsel has submitted that petitioner has already been joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 06.02.2019, passed by this court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
