Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar and in terms of which the petitioner has been called upon to make good the deficient stamp duty/fee in relation to a sale deed dated 17.01.2018 for property measuring 1 kanal, 6 marlas and 4 sarsahi.
