Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to take action against respondents No.5 to 37 as they are interfering in the land of petitioners although a civil decree has been passed in favour of the petitioners. With further prayer to decide representations (P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.3—Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab, is directed to look into representations (P-3 colly), filed by the petitioners, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the

case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3–Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab, to look into representations (P-3 colly), moved by the petitioners and do the needful, if required, within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
