The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.431 dated 04.06.2018, under Sections 307/34 IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Gurugram Sadar, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is stated that co-accused had fired shots in the air. No one had been injured in the incident. The petitioner has been arraigned on the disclosure statement of the co-accused Nikhil @ Nitin that he was part of the conspiracy. He also states that the petitioner is in custody since 15.08.2018.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI R.K. Kataria, states that 7 out of 27 witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 9 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
