Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.123 dated 14.11.2018 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 25.02.2019 passed by this Court, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and the petitioner as well as the complainant were directed to remain present in the Court on 27.02.2019.

On 27.02.2019, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre and a report dated 22.05.2019 has been received from the Mediator.

As per report of the Mediator, the parties have settled their disputes by way of amicable settlement. The settlement/compromise dated

22.05.2019 is also attached with the report.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and the settlement/compromise dated 22.05.2019 has been reduced into writing, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

However, if the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days' notice be given to him.

The parties shall adhere to the terms & conditions of the settlement/compromise dated 22.05.2019 in letter and spirit.
