Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the FIR No. 183 dated 14.11.2008, under Sections 382, 341, 342 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27 and 54 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur on the basis of compromise dated 12.09.2018 entered into between the parties alongwith all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

On instructions from the police officer who is present in the Court, learned State counsel has apprised the Court that no record pertaining to the FIR in question is available with the Punjab Police. Further states that after investigation in the matter, cancellation report was prepared on 13.01.2010.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the matter and the present petition is disposed off as such.

However, it is clarified that in case the petitioner feels aggrieved in future, he will be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy

available under law.
