Present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.52 dated 07.05.2015, registered under Sections 426, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Ajnala.

Though the petitioner had come with the plea that a sum of Rs.14,00,000/- has already been deposited with the complainant, but as per learned State counsel, no amount has been deposited with the complainant or any other account by the petitioner so far. The petitioner is not in a position to produce any document in support of his contention.

Taking into consideration the allegations against the petitioner and the fact that the petitioner is wanted for the purpose of custodial interrogation in this case, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. As such, the present petition is dismissed.
