This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to consider and decide the representations dated 14.12.2018 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) submitted by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 - Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation dated 14.12.2018 (Annexure P-8) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr.Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl.AG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2

-Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana to consider and decide the representation

dated 14.12.2018 (Annexure P-8) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment after giving an effective opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
