The petitioners, who are residents of village Rajlu Garhi, Tehsil Ganaur, District Sonapat (Haryana), purport to have approached this Court in public interest.

A writ in the nature of mandamus is prayed for commanding the respondent-authorities to ensure completion/execution of the pending work as regards special repair of existing road from Ganaur to Rajlu Garhi via Bhogipur (road ID 6081) in Ganaur Constituency in Sonapat District.

2. The limited grievance that the petitioners have is that even though the work in question was assigned to a contractor, but owing to the inaction and lax attitude of the erring officials of the respondent-authorities, it was left in between. It is urged that more than eighteen months have passed by, but the matter has not made any tangible progress. So much so the repeated representation as also the representation dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-8), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response. As a result, the public at large continues to suffer.

3. Having argued the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits as the representation dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-8) is pending consideration and no decision is taken thereupon, let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners and resort to suitable measures.

4. In the wake of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, we dispose of this petition only with a direction to the respondents to consider and deal with the representation of the petitioners dated 11.12.2018 (Annexure P-8), if indeed any is pending, within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order, and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.
