Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.181 dated 29.10.2018 under Sections 452, 354, 354-B and 506 IPC as well as Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 registered against the petitioner at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Perusal of the aforesaid FIR reveals that the allegations against the petitioner are that on 28.10.2018 at about 05.30 p.m., the family members of the complainant were not at home. In the meantime, the petitioner entered the house of the complainant as she was alone at that time, and started doing obscene act with her and when she resisted. He caught hold of her and threw her on a bed and kissed her lips and also touched her breasts.

Therefore, having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the fact that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature, this Court finds that no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
