The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.06 dated 05.01.2019, under Sections 353, 186, 332, 224, 225 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City II Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations against the petitioners in the FIR are that the petitioners had assaulted the police officials, however, none of the police officials had been medico-legally examined.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 06.02.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the investigating officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on *ad interim* bail to the satisfaction of the investigating/arresting officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and no custodial interrogation is required

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 06.02.2019 granting *ad interim* bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
