Prayer made in the petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6, who are father, mother and brother of petitioner No.1-Shivani Garg.

The respondents No.4 to 6 appeared through their counsel and the case was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre for counselling of the parties and for recording their statements. In the statement, the petitioners No.1 has stated that she has met her parents and brother, who have assured that they will not interference in her married life and she is free to go with petitioner No.2-Abhishek Tiwari, husband. Similar statements were made by Krishan Garg and Sunita Garg, who are father and mother of petitioner-Shivani Garg that they have no objection to the marriage of their daughter with Abhishek Tiwari and they will perform their marriage in accordance with rites and ceremonies.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

However, respondent No.2 is directed to look into the grievances of the petitioners, if any, on the basis of any threat, perception and take appropriate action, in accordance with law.
