Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to constitute a Special Investigation Team (SIT) for investigating the FIR No.124 dated 21.11.2018 under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Women Police Station, Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that after registration of the case, no action has been taken by the police. The dowry articles and money given at the time of marriage is required to be recovered from the accused.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The plea of the petitioner that no action has been taken by the police so far, cannot be accepted as respondents No.5, 8 and 9, namely, Balwinder Singh, Amarjeet Kaur and Gurvinder Singh have already been arrested in the case, though they have been granted bail later on. Moreover, the FIR in question was registered on 21.11.2018 and it is but presumed that the same is under investigation. Therefore, no ground for interference is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
