The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 6 dated 05.01.2019, under Sections 379-B and 427 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dharuhera, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations in the FIR are that a sum of Rs.18,250/- which were in the pocket of the complainant and Rs.1500/- in the pocket of Muna Khan had been snatched by four boys, who had also caused damage to the truck of the complainant. He further contends that the petitioners are not involved in any other case and they have joined investigation in terms of the order dated 15.02.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pritam Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the petitioners have joined investigation, interim order dated 15.02.2019 granting ad-interim bail to the petitioners is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
