AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a litigation between a husband and wife with regard to maintenance provided under the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955. During the contempt proceedings, this Court has been apprised that husband had undergone one month's sentence in the execution proceedings for maintenance provided under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

The husband who was present in the Court on the last date, had stated that he was not in a financial position to comply with the directions of the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner though disputed the said fact, stated that respondent has indulged into certain transactions during the interregnum period to defeat the rights of the

petitioner. The said action of him was also in violation of the undertaking given. He candidly submits that execution application is already pending.

He states that liberty be granted to avail remedies in accordance with law for getting the amount of interim maintenance awarded by the Court.

The contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
