This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.244 dated 28.09.2016 registered under Sections 302/201/202/34 IPC at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has now been in custody for more than 2 ½ years and the case is nowhere near conclusion.

Custody certificate dated 29.04.2019 by way of affidavit of Vivek Sangwan, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail (Ambala), Haryana on behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite. As per custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 2 years, 6 months and 26 days.

Learned State counsel has accepted that trial is going to take time. Though I am aware that it is a murder case but it can not be lost sight of that it is a blind murder case.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
