GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.30, dated 14.8.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, Tehsil and District Pathankot, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 IPC, and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 7.2.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Pathankot, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant Sukhwinder Singh as well as of petitioners/accused Harjeet Singh alias Sabu, Gurpreet Singh alias Kaka and Harmeet Singh alias

Bagga, have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that the matter has been compromised with the petitioners and he does not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Pathankot, opined that the compromise effected between the parties appears to be genuine, voluntary and without any pressure.

4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.30, dated 14.8.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, Tehsil and District Pathankot, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 IPC, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
