The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 10 and further issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate action in FIR No.428, dated 20.12.2018 which was registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 149 of IPC at Police Station- Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

The grievance made in this petition is that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized against the wishes of the family members of petitioner No.2 who have been arrayed as respondents No.4 to 10 in the present petition. The aforesaid respondents are threatening the petitioners as well as their family members. The petitioners earlier also filed a petition bearing No. **CRM-M-10606 of 2014**, titled as “**Charanjit Kaur and another vs. State of Punjab**”, which was disposed of on 26.03.2014 by

this Court by directing the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to consider and expeditiously dispose of the representation of the petitioners regarding threat to their lives and liberty. Thereafter, despite this direction the respondents are continuously threatening to kill the petitioners. The petitioners were attacked several times and thus the aforesaid FIR was registered.

Despite the aforesaid FIR, the respondents have not mend their ways and are continuously harassing and threatening the petitioners. In this regard, the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 21.12.2018 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, wherein details of the incidents by the respondents have been mentioned.

In the light of aforesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners, as raised by them in the representation dated 21.12.218 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law.
