JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner-Harpal Singh, is a resident of Agual, Tehsil Nabha, District Patiala and has been held to be an unauthorised occupant of 2 bighas of land comprised in khasra No.870 and another 2 bighas and 13 biswas land comprised in khasra No.871 recorded in the ownership of Gram Panchayat as per the jamabandi for 2011-12, thereby ordered to be evicted vide decision dated 10.04.2018 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by the Collector, Patiala, on the application under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 instituted by the Gram Panchayat. The said findings are based upon a demarcation report dated 01.12.2017 (**Ex.P-4/A**). The appeal filed by the petitioner was also dismissed vide order dated 09.01.2019 (**Annexure P-2**) passed by the Joint Commissioner, Development (exercising the powers of Commissioner).

At the time of initial hearing on 15.02.2019, counsel for the petitioner had sought time to place on record the certified copy of the objections, if any, filed against the demarcation report before the Collector, who has passed the eviction order (**Annexure P-1**).

Thereafter on two subsequent dates adjournments were sought.

At the time of resumed hearing today, the case was called twice and neither anybody has appeared on behalf of the petitioner nor said objections have been placed on record.

Dismissed in default.
