The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 139 dated 10.02.2018, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 307, 34 IPC, at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 15.03.2018. Six more PWs remain to be examined and thus, the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and no specific role has been attributed to him in the FIR and thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 12.02.2019 prepared by Sh. Shamsher Singh Dahiya, SP, Superintendent of Prison, Central Jail No.1, Hisar, Haryana has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. According to the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual

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custody of 10 months and 27 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

The factual submissions made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner have not been denied by learned State counsel.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned, at Hisar.
