Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.308 dated 22.12.2018 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, Ludhiana Rural.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 07.02.2019:-

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and there is no direct allegations against him. It is further submitted that the petitioner is only the Scriber of the agreement to sell and is neither a beneficiary of the same nor he has identified any wrong person.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Karamjeet Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.02.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
