Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No. 4 dated 10.1.2019, under Sections 326, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

According to the prosecution, in the evening of 6.12.2018 when complainant Tasveer Singh along with his son Harpreet Singh was sowing wheat, petitioners No. 1-Nirmal Singh armed with iron rod, petitioners No. 2-Kirpal Singh and no. 5-Harpal Singh armed with datar, petitioners No. 3-Udham Singh and no.4- Gurmukh Singh armed with dang and sticks, inflicted multiple injuries to the complainant.

Learned counsel contends that it is a case of cross version between the petitioner and the complainant party, in which petitioner No. 5 was caused multiple grievous injuries by the complainant party, detailed in Annexures P2 to P5. No role is attributed to petitioner No.4. The petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case. Injury attributed to petitioner No.2 is not on vital part of injured Tasveer Singh.

Considering the factum of causing multiple grievous injuries, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
