Present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.60 dated 21.05.2018 under Sections 458, 379-B, 395, 397 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Mohana, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 08.06.2018 and trial of the case still to take some more time, so the petitioner be also released on bail in this case.

Learned State counsel contended that there are total four eye witnesses in this case and out of them three witnesses have already been examined and have supported the prosecution case. One eye witness, namely, Rajan Nath is not traceable despite best efforts.

Having consideration the submissions made by learned counsel for both the parties and keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner,

present petition is disposed of with direction to learned trial Judge to decide the trial of the case expeditiously and preferably within a period of four months from today.
