HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the seniority position of the petitioner was at No.6376 whereas one Rajbir Singh was at seniority position No.8295.

It is contended that Mr. Rajbir Singh belongs to the reserved category and achieved excellent promotion on the basis of reservation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that Mr.Rajbir Singh was promoted as a Lecturer on 07.05.1992 by superseding the petitioner and the petitioner was also promoted as a Lecturer on 01.12.2007 and therefore, he is entitled for up-gradation of his pay equivalent to his junior.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 31.08.2018 (Annexure P-9) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for, he will not be given any arrears and his grant of benefit will only be notionally from the date of the filing of the writ petition.
