Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.1066 dated 24.10.2018, under Sections 120-B, 170, 384 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'IPC'), registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

This Court passed the following order on 27.02.2019 :-

“Contents that petitioner is neither named in the FIR nor any other criminal case is pending against him. Also contends that petitioner has been nominated on the disclosure statement of co-accused Hemant Pandey.

Learned State counsel seeks time to have instructions as to whether any criminal case is pending against the petitioner?

Adjourned to 29.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his

furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramesh Kumar has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 27.02.2019 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the present petition is disposed off.
