By way of filing this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take effective steps against respondents No.4 to 7 with regard to FIR No.0349 dated 10.12.2018 registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Chandigarh, District Chandigarh, U.T. under Sections 323, 326, 34 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that son of the petitioner was given beatings by respondents No.4 to 6 regarding which the aforesaid FIR was lodged but despite a period of two months having elapsed, the police has not taken any effective step to conduct necessary investigation. So much so, the police has not even formally arrested the accused.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of

Police, U.T., Chandigarh to ensure that necessary steps for investigation of the matter are taken immediately and that the investigation is not unnecessarily delayed.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
