ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in Crime Case No.040/2017 dated 21.06.2017 under Sections 8/18/20/29 and 60 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, “NDPS Act”), registered at Police Station NCB Zonal Unit, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated after more than a year.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent, while referring to the supplementary complaint has submitted that all efforts to arrest the petitioner failed and even the warrants issued by the Court did not yield any fruitful result. The petitioner, thereafter, was declared as a proclaimed offender and arrested in a raid. Learned counsel for the respondent has also submitted that out of 09 prosecution witnesses, 02 witnesses have already been examined. He submits that the prosecution

would conclude its evidence within four month.

In view of the aforesaid situation, it is considered appropriate to request the learned trial Court/Special Judge to make a sincere endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of six months.

With these observations, the petition stands disposed of.
