The petitioner/complainant Sahil has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to get the matter pertaining to FIR No.486 dated 20.7.2018 registered at Police Station Sector 58, Faridabad under Sections 379-B, 341, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 investigated fairly and impartially and to submit a final report at the earliest.

The learned counsel has submitted that although the FIR in question was registered about seven months back but the police has neither arrested any of the accused nor has conducted any effective investigation in the matter. On the other hand, the accused are pressuring the petitioner to effect a compromise in the matter.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-The Commissioner of

Police, Faridabad, District Faridabad to look into the matter and to ensure that the matter pertaining to FIR No.486 dated 20.7.2018 registered at Police Station Sector 58, Faridabad under Sections 379-B, 341, 323, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 is got investigated fairly and expeditiously and also to ensure that the complainant is not pressurized to effect a compromise at the instance of the accused and that a final report is submitted at the earliest.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-The Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, District Faridabad so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
