In this petition, petitioner is seeking direction to the respondents to grant the benefits of earned leaves and other consequential benefits from the date his services has been regularized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to the order dated 09.05.2017 (Annexure P/1) whereby services of the petitioner have been regularized from the date of his initial appointment i.e. 23.07.2008, however, benefits of earned leaves and ACP have not been granted. With regard to his grievance, petitioner has already made a representation dated 28.08.2018 (Annexure P/7) to respondent no.3 – General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Yamuna Nagar, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is being disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 –

General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Yamuna Nagar, to look into the representation (Annexure P-7) and pass a speaking order thereon within a period of four months in accordance with law.
