The petitioners allege that the private respondents duped them by promising to send them abroad. Money to the tune of Rs.14 lacs was paid but forged visas and tickets were issued. Although a detailed representation dated 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been submitted, the police has failed to take any action thereupon. Earlier also, representation dated 7.5.2018 (Annexure P-4) had been submitted.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 4.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice. Let five copies of the complete paper book be supplied to him during the course of day. Considering the nature of order being passed, no notice is necessary to be issued to respondents No.5 to 8.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representations dated 7.5.2018 (Annexure P-4) and 21.11.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case found necessary, within a period of eight weeks.
