Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Naveen @ Babu, in case FIR No. 818 dated 21.08.2017 registered under Sections 302 and 323 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Gurugram.

The petitioner is facing trial in the aforesaid FIR, for committing the murder of Rudarpartap.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that all the material witnesses have turned hostile. Petitioner is in custody since 21.08.2017. Conclusion of trial may take sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining him in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel also conceded that all the material witnesses have turned hostile.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without

expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner-Naveen @ Babu, is ordered to be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
