This is the second round of litigation initiated by the petitioner concern.

Earlier in point of time CWP No.3984 of 2018 was filed for release of the 30% margin money subsidy under the Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS) introduced by the Government of India, Ministry of Textiles to assist the Textiles and Jute Industries.

It is after filing of the afore-noticed writ petition that the subsidy amount was released. Writ petition accordingly was rendered infructuous on 16.11.2018.

However at that stage, counsel had sought liberty to pursue the matter with the respondents for grant of interest on account of delayed release of subsidy. Such liberty was granted by this Court.

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of the representation having been filed for payment of interest, the same had not been responded.

Without ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the writ petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondents No.1 and 2, to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of the representation dated 25.11.2018 (Annexure P-12), strictly in accordance with law and to take a final decision thereupon and conveyed the same to the petitioner firm within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is clarified that this Court has not examined the claim of the petitioner for award of interest on merits.

Disposed of.
