Petitioner seeks a mandamus directing the respondents- Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to reinstate the petitioner on the post of Sewer Man in Zone B-2, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana.

The instant petition is completely bereft of any details with regard to the appointment of the petitioner on the post of Sewer Man in the first instance. Counsel has not even been able to apprise this Court as to whether the post of Sewer Man had at any point being advertised and which led to the engagement of the petitioner. Without there being any material for this Court to infer that petitioner had been engaged (if at all) on the post of Sewer Man after following the due procedure of selection and appointment in terms of Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India, no rights possibly could come to vest in him so as to raise the prayer, seeking reinstatement.

No basis for interference is made out on the strength of pleadings on record.

Petition dismissed.
