Prayer made in this writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the notice dated 24.05.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1-bank and auction sale publication notice dated 05.02.2019 (Annexure P-3).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal or to avail the alternative remedies as are available to him, in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
