As per office report, respondent No.2 has been served through her son. However, no one is present on her behalf.

An FIR No.37 dated 20.06.2013 (Anexure P-1) was registered on the application of respondent No.2 under Sections 447, 511, 294, 506, 420, 149 IPC at Police Station City, Raikot, District Ludhiana. During investigation, the parties have entered into a settlement and respondent No.2 filed an affidavit with the Investigating Agency on 05.07.2013. There was a written compromise (Annexure P-3) between the parties which was also submitted to the Investigating Agency.

On the basis thereof, the police filed cancellation report on 28.08.2013 under Section 173 Cr.P.C. It has been brought to the notice of the Court that since the year 2013, respondent No.2-first informant has not come forward although repeated efforts have been made to serve her by the Court of Magistrate.

the Court towards the Sale Deed (Annexure P-4) which was executed by the petitioners in favour of respondent No.2-first informant. He submits that the terms of the settlement have been complied with by the petitioners.

Keeping in view the uncontroverted facts which are not disputed by the State counsel, on instructions from SI Ramanpreet Singh, this Court is of the view that ends of justice would be met if FIR No.37 dated 20.06.2013 (Anexure P-1) registered under Sections 447, 511, 294, 506, 420, 149 IPC at Police Station City, Raikot, District Ludhiana, is ordered to be closed.

Ordered accordingly.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
